Alternatives Medical Clinic

We are glad you came in for your appointment. The medical care we offer is limited to pregnancy diagnosis and includes positive pregnancy test verification when requested. Please contact one of the doctors or clinics on our referral sheet for your follow-up prenatal care as soon as possible. If you are applying for Medi-Cal or AIM, it is important that you do so right away. Early prenatal care is essential for the health of you and your baby.

WARNING SIGNS OF PREGNANCY

Watch for these danger signs while you are pregnant: Call your doctor right away if you have:

- Fever or chills, with temp over 102 F or 38.8 C
- Any bleeding from your vagina.
- Severe vomiting or diarrhea.
- Severe abdominal pain and /or continual cramping, not relieved by bowel movement.
- Frequent, painful or burning urination (pee)

Don't wait. Call right away if you:

- Have a really terrible headache, or headache that goes on for days.
- Feel dizzy
- Have any change in your eyesight-blurred vision; see stars or pinpoints of light.
- Face & hands swell up.

Later in Pregnancy, You should also call right away if you have:

- There is a big change in the way your baby moves, or if your baby moves less often or is not moving.
- A sharp pain when you urinate.
- A sudden gush or trickle of fluid from your vagina.

You may have signs of early labor (after 20 weeks but before 37 weeks):

CALL RIGHT AWAY if:

- Your uterus tightens up more than 5 times in one hour, or more often than every 10 minutes.
- You have lower backache. You may feel pain or dull pressure in your back.
- Your lower abdomen may hurt. You may feel pain or pressure in your thighs or around your vagina.
- You have a stomach ache or cramps. You may have diarrhea.
- You see a change in the discharge that comes out of your vagina.

If you have any of the following: GO TO THE NEAREST EMERGENCY ROOM!!

- You have any injury to your abdomen, fall or are in any car accident.
- Severe vaginal bleeding and/ or severe abdominal pain.

Description

Some (but not all) of the reasons for abnormal

Weakness, confusion, and blackouts which can happen with blood loss.

Miscarriage and ectopic pregnancies can have serious complications. Please call your doctor immediately or seek medical care at your local hospital Emergency Room if you have any of the signs or symptoms listed above.

Call 911 if you have severe pain or severe bleeding and/or signs of shock. Signs of shock may include blackouts, lightheadedness, restlessness, confusion, weakness, moist skin or profuse sweating, and a fast heart rate.
